Functional Independence Measure (FIM) - Strokengine

The Functional Independence Measure (FIM) scale assesses physical and cognitive disability.¹ This scale focuses on the burden of care - that is, the level of disability indicating the burden of caring for them. Scoring Items are scored on the level of assistance required for an individual to perform activities of daily living. The scale includes 18 items, of which 13 items are physical ...

Functional Independence Measure - JC Physiotherapy

The Functional Independence Measure (FIM) is a global measure of disability and can be scored alone or with the additional 12 items that formulate the Functional Assessment Measure (FAM). FAM does not stand alone, hence the abbreviation of FIM+FAM. The original items were developed by Santa Clara Valley Medical Center (SCVMC) but extrapolation to the UK was not directly possible, therefore a ...
