Press and hold both the ACTIVITY and CHANNEL DOWN buttons on the front of the TV for at least 5 seconds. The LED on the front of the set will start blinking a 2-digit code to indicate the type of problem detected. For example, the sequence: blink-blink, pause, blink-blink-blink, indicates an error code of 23.
