The prevalence of overt hypothyroidism in the general population varies between 0–3% and 3–7% in the USA and between 0–2% and 5–3% in Europe, 4–8 depending on the definition used. A meta-analysis 7 of studies across nine European countries estimated the prevalence of undiagnosed hypothyroidism, including both overt and mild cases, at around 5%.
